To ensure academic success, you should carefully consider whether to use the Pass/No Pass grading option. The grade option for a course may be changed through the [Summer Session office](#) until the last day of instruction for each session.



PASS/NO PASS MAY BE A GOOD OPTION IF...

- You are struggling with the transition to remote learning.
- You feel this course will hurt your GPA. Refer to [StudentAccess GPA calculator](#).
- You have special circumstances that prevent you from performing to your typical standard.



PASS/NO PASS MAY NOT BE A GOOD OPTION IF...

- You are looking to boost your GPA and feel this course grade may help. Refer to [StudentAccess GPA calculator](#).
- You are repeating a course previously taken for a letter grade.



ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

- "Pass" and "No Pass" grades do not impact your GPA.
- A 'C' grade or higher is needed to "Pass" and receive credit.
- If you are on academic probation, letter grades may be needed to improve your GPA.
