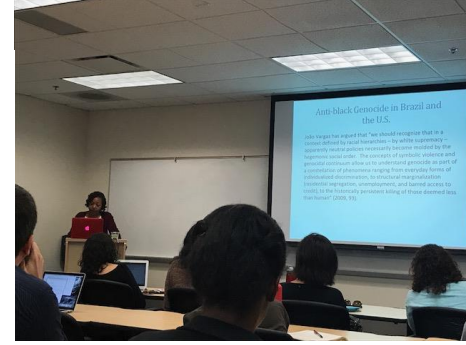

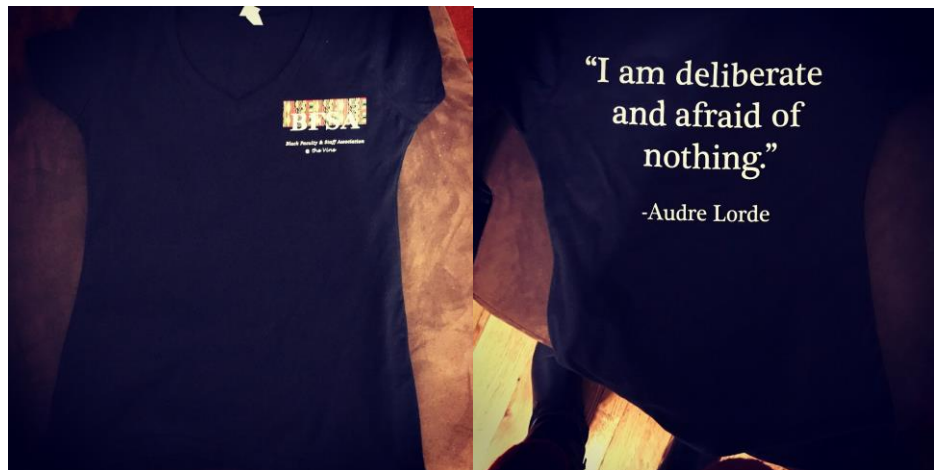
## Lecture by Professor Kia Lilly Caldwell professor of African, African American and Diaspora Studies
