

## **GPACS 2019 Graduate Student Small Grant Opportunity**

The Center for Global Peace and Conflict Studies at UCI is pleased to offer small grants to graduate students for research projects relevant to the Center's mission and interests on Peace and Conflict. Students may apply for up to \$1800 to travel for research purposes, pay for other significant research expenses, or attend a conference (after department and school funding has been exhausted).

The mission of GPACS is to promote research and interdisciplinary interactions on Peace and Conflict and the proposed project must indicate its relevance to this mission. All other things being equal, we will give priority to students who regularly participate in Center activities. Each grant recipient will be expected to present results of their research at either the graduate student conference or the GPACS lunch during the 2019-29 academic year.

- Your name, department, year you entered your PhD program, and whether you have advanced to candidacy.
- Title, summary, and description of your project (not to exceed 750 words).
- A proposed budget that describes the activities to be supported by GPACS funding and whether you have received or expect to receive funding from other sources.
- GPACS activities that you participated over the past year.
- Have a faculty letter of support in pdf sent to [Lina.Moncayo@uci.edu](mailto:Lina.Moncayo@uci.edu) as well.

**The deadline for submission of proposals is March 11, 2019.**

Funding decisions will be made by April 17, 2019.
