The Asian Pacific Islander Capitol Association (APICA) seeks interns for their 2023 Summer Internship Program in Sacramento!

APICA is a non-partisan, non-profit organization of legislative staffers, lobbyists, and advocates, as well as other API professionals in the Capitol Community in Sacramento. As part of their community and staff development efforts, APICA hosts a 10-week summer internship at the State Capitol in Sacramento from June 19, 2023 to August 25, 2023. The internship is for current college students, 21 years of age or older at the time of the internship, who are interested in public policy and public service.

The program provides participants with a **\$4,960 stipend**, an orientation and introduction to state government, mentorship with API Capitol staff, and a substantive, meaningful work experience in a legislative office in either the **California State Assembly** or **California State Senate**. This internship will be conducted in-person in Sacramento, California. All students are welcome to apply.

Applications are due on **Sunday, March 5th, 2023**. Please use this <u>Google Form application</u> to submit all application materials.

A virtual information session on the internship will be held on Thursday, February 23rd from 5:30-6:30PM. The session will provide an overview of the program, discuss requirements and deadlines, and include a brief Q&A Session. Register for the Zoom link here.
