OPPORTUNITY FROM THE UCI LABOR CENTER:

Labor Summer comes to Orange County! The UCI Labor Center is coordinating <u>Labor Summer</u> internships for UCI students and partnering with the UCB Labor Center for orientation. Here's what Labor Summer looks like for UCI undergraduate and graduate students:

- 8-week, full-time, PAID internship with an Orange County labor union or community organization
- Two tracks: Organizing Track and Research & Policy Track
- 1 week of orientation at UC Berkeley (June 20 24)
- 7 weeks at internship site in Orange County (40 hours per week; June 26 August 10)
- 2 training sessions at UCI during internship
- 2 3 mentor conversations
- August 11 graduation in Oakland

For the orientation week at UCB, the UCI Labor Center will cover travel expenses to/from UCB and provide room and board. The UCI Labor Center will also cover travel expenses to/from Oakland for the August 11 graduation. If you are graduating in June, you are eligible to apply for Labor Summer.

The Gilder Lehrman Institute provides annual short-term research fellowships in the amount of \$3000 each for undergraduates to come to New York to do research at the Gilder Lehrman Collection and other archives. Each applicant is required to submit a brief project proposal as well as an annotated list of five documents from the Gilder Lehrman Collection to be used in the project.
