Policy for Application for 2nd B.A.

UCI School of Humanities 2nd Baccalaureate programs are intended for students needing to complete coursework in a single discipline, different than the field of their first degree, to later move forward with corresponding graduate programs or career goals.

Admitted 2nd B.A. students are subject to the following regulations in Humanities:

- Degree requirements must be completed in six quarters of attendance, excluding summers.
- You may only enroll in courses that apply toward the major to which you were admitted.
- You may not change majors once admitted into a Humanities 2nd B.A. program.
- You may not add a minor or an additional major to your degree. Special considerations may be made in situations in which the student needs additional units to complete their degree.
- You may not participate in special undergraduate programs including (but not limited to) study abroad (UCEAP or independent programs), UCDC, UC Sacramento, and UTeach.

Applicants for a 2nd Baccalaureate in the UCI School of Humanities must meet required prerequisites in that field to apply. Carefully review major requirements listed on the [Office of Undergraduate Study website](#).

Note that completion of the minimum required prerequisites does NOT guarantee admission. Lower-division major courses may be completed at the community college prior to enrolling at UCI.

Deadlines: You must apply for readmission as a second B.A. student by the following deadlines: August 1 for fall quarter, November 1 for winter quarter and February 1 for spring quarter. Contact an Academic Counselor in the School of Humanities to initiate the readmission process after you have successfully met the readmission eligibility criteria.

Supplemental application materials:

Submit responses to the prompts below to Ashlee Walker at ashleemw@uci.edu. Along with your responses, please also submit a current resume and a sample course plan for your 2nd B.A. program completion. You may use the [Humanities course plan template](#) and the [major course guide](#) for your intended major.

Limit 500 words per prompt:

1. Detail your future educational and/or career goals and how they relate to your new proposed degree.
2. Indicate previous experience or training relating to your proposed degree that qualifies you to attempt the courses in your proposed 2nd B.A.
3. List any additional time commitments you may have while completing your 2nd B.A. such as part-time or full-time work.
