History 190 (topics vary) - Colloquium <i>History 190 courses are specialized courses dealing primarily with close readings and analysis of secondary works; required reports and critical essays. Each colloquium reflects the instructor's intellectual interests and is conducted as a discussion group.</i> <i>Enrollment is restricted to students with upper-division standing.</i>	1)
