## All courses for the major must be taken for letter grades

Residency Requirement in the major: History 70C, History 100W, History 190 and three upper-division History courses must be successfully completed at UCI. By petition, two of the six may be taken through the UC Education Abroad Program, provided that course content is approved in advance by the Chair of the History Undergraduate Program Committee.

<b>History 100W</b> - Research Seminar <i>History 100W should be taken early in the sophomore year.</i> <i>Prerequisite: satisfactory completion of lower-division writing. If you completed lower-division writing at another school and are unable to register for a class, please submit a Course Authorization Request on the Humanities Undergraduate website (<a href="http://www.humanities.uci.edu/undergrad">www.humanities.uci.edu/undergrad</a>).</i> <i>History 100W will satisfy the upper-division writing requirement if passed with a grade of C or better.</i>	1)
<b>History 190</b> (topics vary) - Colloquium <i>History 190 courses are specialized courses dealing primarily with close readings and analysis of secondary works; required reports and critical essays. Each colloquium reflects the instructor's intellectual interests and is conducted as a discussion group.</i> <i>Prerequisite: Enrollment is restricted to students with upper-division standing.</i>	1)
