

Undergraduate Summer Fellowship in the Digital Humanities (USFDH) Call for Applications

Humanities majors: Are you curious about the digital humanities? Are you interested in how you can combine your own research interests with digital technologies? In the **Undergraduate Summer Fellowship in the Digital Humanities (USFDH)**, you can enhance your research and technology skills by learning about digital humanities and developing your own project prototype!

The School of Humanities, in partnership with UCI Libraries and the Digital Humanities Exchange (DHX), is pleased to announce that applications are now open for the 2024 <u>USFDH program</u>. Accepted fellows will receive a \$1,200 stipend upon successful completion of the program. In the USFDH, you will:

- · Learn about digital humanities methods in a series of virtual workshops.
- Receive support from UCI's Research Librarian for the Digital Humanities, subject librarians, and Humanities faculty.
- Develop a digital humanities project prototype based on your own research interests and share this prototype in a public showcase in Fall 2024.

The fellowship will be conducted virtually during the summer quarter (June-September), with an in-person orientation for accepted applicants held at the end of spring quarter.

To apply: Complete and submit <u>the application form</u> by **Friday, April 19 at 11:59pm**. Award notifications will be sent by Friday, May 3.
